

Become a PEP-Recognized Instructor



PERC Education Program (PEP) is the new way that the propane industry will train its workforce. It takes the key learnings of the Certified Employee Training Program (CETP) and breaks them down into smaller task-specific modules and programs that are easier for the learner to retain. PEP will be available in The Learning Center, yet all the training can be taught in person as well.

Anyone can conduct PEP training in person, using the Training Toolkits available through PERC. Each toolkit includes PowerPoint presentations, instructor notes, and learner workbooks in PDF format, as well as quizzes for each module.

Become a PEP-Recognized Instructor by completing the following three steps:

- ▶ The PEP you plan to teach
- ▶ PEP-Recognized Instructor training program
- ▶ PEP-Recognized Instructor program evaluation

In 2025 you will have two options for completing the PEP-Recognized Instructor program.

OPTION ONE

Attending one of the 2-day in-person events being held. These sessions will include the training part and the evaluation for the PEP-Recognized Instructor requirements. The only requirement remaining will be to complete the Learning Path you wish to instruct.

OPTION TWO

2. Attend a virtual one-day session to connect the learning materials.
3. Successfully complete the virtual evaluation session after completing the one-day training session.
