





The Propane Education & Research Council (PERC) is a not-for-profit organization that provides state-of-the-art propane safety and training programs, invests in research and development of new propane-powered technologies, and educates consumers about the uses and benefits of propane. Operated and funded by the propane industry, its programs target a variety of markets including transportation, agriculture, residential and commercial building, off-road, material handling, and power generation.

Guided by four strategic priorities in 2024, PERC helped introduce innovations in power generation, agriculture, ports, and technical and safety training programs to meet climate and energy challenges.

Develop professional, informed, and skilled workforce and trade allies through world-class safety and technical training.

For years, propane professionals received their training through the Certified Employee Training Program (CETP). In 2024, PERC began rolling out the next innovation in training for the propane industry. The PERC Education Program (PEP) is a new employee training program that's function-based, modular, and completely customizable.





PEP's goal is to move away from the current one-size-fits-all approach to one that puts the focus on training in the necessary skills for specific jobs, ensuring employees are focused on learning the information they truly need. The PERC Safety Team, with direction from the Council and working group, began phasing out CETP in 2024.

As with all of PERC's training content, propane professionals can access PEP through The Learning Center, the propane industry's convenient, central access point for workforce training. In addition to PEP's successful rollout, The Learning Center continues to see marked increases in participating users and companies since its introduction in 2020.

The 528 new companies and 28,799 unique user logins added in 2024 bring the total number of Learning Center users to 5,266 companies and more than 80,000 unique user logins. The number of modules and Learning Paths completed this year, specifically in the technical training, safety, and market and industry categories, represents more than 165,000 hours of online interaction with PERC education materials.

GRANT PROGRAMS

While PERC continues to make great strides in providing the propane professionals of today with world-class training, 2024 saw similar success in reaching the propane professionals of tomorrow with our workforce outreach and education grant programs. These programs bring up-to-date propanespecific education to our allied partners and build awareness of propane's expansive applications in a variety of careers.

The HVAC Technical School Grant Program accepted 30 schools in 2024. This grant program provides high school, community college, and technical college students with enhanced, realworld experience working with propane distribution systems. Through the program, schools expand their current curriculum with additional propane training and acquire specific propane equipment and appliances, adding unique hands-on learning opportunities and preparing students for a future in the propane industry.

The Propane Autogas Vehicle Inspection Grant Program accepted 40 schools in 2024. This grant program provides technical schools and community colleges with a propanespecific curriculum, educational props, and access to industry experts to give aspiring automobile service technicians hands-on experience working with autogas-powered vehicles. This program not only provides students with a unique skill set and more career opportunities after graduation, but also helps create more advocates for propane use in the automotive industry.



Engage in commercialization efforts to create market growth opportunities.

PERC is responsible for leading the development of safe, clean, propane-powered solutions that Americans trust today and the innovations that they'll rely on tomorrow. We foster new product technology that helps inspire Americans to choose propane at home, at work, on the road, and on the farm — anywhere they need clean, reliable energy.

PERC investments accelerate the research, development, and demonstration of innovative, propane-powered appliances, equipment, and vehicles that reduce emissions and save money for homeowners, businesses, farms, and fleets.



POWER GENERATION

As the demand for resilient primary and backup power accelerates, PERC and its partners continue to displace diesel and position propane as the new standard for a rapidly growing market. In 2024, PERC grew users and uses of propane

in the off-road market by demonstrating propane's and propane-powered equipment's affordability, low total cost of ownership, and environmental benefits to rental and construction equipment business owners. This strategy led to the deployment of



hundreds of propane-powered towable generators across our various partners at Eco Power Equipment, ANA, MESA, and Wildcat.

In 2024, PERC also concluded a three-year partnership with Qnergy, resulting in the development of a standalone, hybrid NanoGrid Power Generation Package based on Qnergy's PowerGen Platform. Ideal for electric vehicle (EV) charging, this hybrid technology creates an opportunity for a network of distributed, autonomous, resilient, and reliable charging stations powered by propane.

SOIL STEAMER

While steaming has been a proven and effective method for soil disinfection, the lack of appropriate equipment has made it economically unfeasible for large, commercial-scale farms. A revolutionary new, propane-powered Soil



Steamer changes that by significantly reducing weed seedling emergence on raised beds while maximizing potential yield of high-value crops without chemicals — ultimately growing healthier food for families.

After funding its development, PERC hosted several successful demonstrations of the Soil Steamer to prospective buyers in 2024, including more than 600 agriculture professionals at the Organic Grower Summit. So far, two Soil Steamers have been purchased for commercial-scale farms, one of those purchases by the California Strawberry Commission.

TERMINAL TRACTORS

The terminal tractor market is also experiencing rapid growth. Four manufacturers — MAFI, Taylor, Capacity, and Tyco — now offer propane-powered terminal tractors, all utilizing the PSI-88 engine. Additionally, Tyco is working to integrate the ROUSH CleanTech 7.3 engine into their lineup, further expanding the range of options available to end users.

In July, PERC presented the Port Newark Container Terminal the Energy for Everyone Hero Award in recognition of their initiative to add near-zero emissions propane-powered terminal tractors to their fleet.



HEAT PUMP HELPER™

Throughout 2024, the Heat Pump Helper[™] Personal Use Program (PUP) and state partnership program aligned PERC funding with funding from state entities interested and engaged in the commercialization of the Heat Pump Helper through a state-by-state grant program. At the conclusion of the program, 46 parties are actively interested, 8 installations are in progress, and 19 installations and 11 surveys have been completed.



Increase propane's share of voice in the national energy conversation through data-driven, provocative, and assertive messaging.

In 2024, the Communications and Marketing Team championed propane's role in a sustainable future with consumers, businesses, farmers, and thought leaders.



SYMPHONY AD CAMPAIGN

PERC launched the Symphony campaign during the summer Olympics in Paris, which drew 30.4 million daily viewers. Through the campaign they saw propane's ability to lower carbon emissions at home, on the road, on farms, and in ports. Our strategic buy guaranteed 86,161,000 impressions, yet the actual delivery surpassed expectations with 145,088,000 impressions — an over delivery of 168%, translating to an added value of more than \$2 million. The Symphony ads contributed significantly to increasing brand visibility, with ad recall rising by 34%, brand recall improving by 70%, and message recall skyrocketing by 180%. This success was in addition to the Olympic flame being fueled by renewable propane for the first time.



The launch of Path to Zero: 12 Climate Conversations that Changed the World on September 24 was the lynchpin of our Environmental Thought Leadership



(ETL) strategy. In his book, PERC President & CEO Tucker Perkins reflects on 12 of his most memorable conversations with renowned climate scientists. academics, and innovators from the Path to Zero podcast. The book not only elevated Perkins' profile as a leading energy expert but also secured his role as a thought leader in the climate space, particularly following his high-profile appearances at Climate Week in New York City. Our targeted ETL ads also proved highly effective, driving 317,200 new users to propane.com.



2024 VIDEO SERIES

To increase multimedia content for propane.com and the industry, the Communications and Marketing Team produced a collection of videos about important topics and innovations across a wide range of market segments including residential and commercial construction, agriculture, autogas, material handling, and more. These videos showcase compelling, real-world examples of propane making a difference in the lives of commercial farmers, fleet managers, and business owners, including the North Penn School District, Southern Living Idea House, and Fisher Vineyards. These videos played a vital role in educating and engaging our audience on propane's versatility, providing valuable insights into the current energy landscape and future trends.

OUTREACH

PERC spent much of 2024 presenting autogas's value proposition in key markets, especially paratransit, student transportation, and corporate fleets. These outreach efforts involved PERC's participation in major national transportation trade shows, including GFX, CTAA, STN East, STN West, and NTICC. PERC also secured keynote addresses at STN East and STN West Transportation Directors Summit and Expos as well as the Transporting Students with Disabilities Conference. PERC staff presented on topics such as "Why the answer is autogas/ propane and EV for school fleets" and "How can propane help me to charge my stranded EV buses?"

AUTOGAS SERVICE CENTER MAP

In 2022, PERC worked with vehicle and system manufacturing partners to make information about technical support, replacement parts, training, and service locations more readily accessible to those seeking qualified autogas service technicians and service centers. This effort led to the development of the Autogas Service Center Map, an interactive map hosted on PERC's website which tracks the growing network of autogas OEM-certified service centers nationwide. Since its introduction, the map has grown from its original size of 500 to nearly 700 service centers. Fleet directors can use the map to find the nearest Alliance AutoGas, Freightliner Custom Chassis, or ROUSH CleanTech facility and contact information.






