You receive \$500 for every qualified propane irrigation engine sold when:

- The producer is new to propane irrigation
- The engine is EPA- and/or CARB-certified
- The sale is entered into the PERC dealer portal
- The customer is enrolled in the Propane Farm Research Program

Why Dealers Are Selling More Propane Irrigation Engines



RELIABLE, GRID-INDEPENDENT POWER

Propane irrigation engines operate independently of the electric grid — no peak-hour restrictions, no curtailments, and no downtime caused by grid interruptions.



READY FOR ALL REGIONS & REGULATIONS

EPA- and CARB-certified propane irrigation engines are available in all 50 states, including regions with diesel restrictions and emissions requirements.



LOWER EMISSIONS WITHOUT COMPROMISING PERFORMANCE

Propane irrigation engines produce up to:

- 8% fewer greenhouse gas emissions and 9% fewer nitrogen oxide (NOx) emissions than diesel models
- 18% fewer greenhouse gas emissions and 19% fewer NOx emissions than gasoline engines



Who This Program Is For

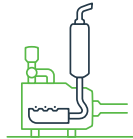
The Propane Irrigation Engine Demonstration Program is designed for irrigation engine dealers working with ag producers who irrigate corn, soybeans, cotton, vegetables, or orchards and are upgrading diesel, gasoline, or electric irrigation engines.

How the Program Works



SIGN UP

Create an account at propane.com/irrigation-dealer to track eligible propane irrigation engine sales.



SELL

Sell an eligible propane-powered irrigation engine to a producer new to propane irrigation.



ENTER

Enter the engine purchase into the dealer portal.



EARN

Once the enrollment is confirmed, you receive \$500.

Added Value That Helps Close the Sale

Ag producers enrolled through the program may qualify for up to \$10,000 in compensation for sharing real-world performance data through the Propane Farm Research Program. This opportunity helps offset upfront equipment costs and strengthen ROI conversations.

Eligible Equipment

Qualified propane-powered industrial engines are:

- New
- EPA- and/or CARB-certified
- Used for agricultural irrigation applications

PFRP compensation may include:

- \$600 per liter of displacement for pumping applications
- Up to \$3,000 for certified dual-fuel systems
