



Propane Autogas Vehicle Inspection Grant Program

Who Can Apply

This program is intended for educational institutions in the U.S. that are already teaching an automotive class and are willing and able to expand their curriculum to include propane-specific material and hands-on resources. Each school is eligible for one grant. Funding is limited.

Funding Details

Approved applicants will receive **\$7,500** worth of grant funds, which includes:

- A propane autogas-specific training aid that is a **\$5,000+** value to include in your training facility. The autogas training aid, provided by PERC in partnership with Blossman Services, is an educational tool designed to demonstrate the various components and systems involved in an autogas-powered vehicle. This prop is a detailed, scale model of a pickup truck frame, showcasing all the critical elements of an autogas system in their actual locations.
- The remaining **\$2,500** of funds will be sent to your school to go towards sending your class instructor to attend a mandatory Train the Trainer class on the *Propane Autogas Vehicle Inspection: Introduction for Automobile Service Technicians* curriculum, and for use in marketing the new incorporation of the curriculum into your school to prospective students.
